- **NCOC daily update: 1,004 new cases, 28 deaths from Covid-19** ISLAMABAD: Pakistan on Sunday confirmed 1,004 new Covid-19 cases and 28 more deaths, the National Command and Operation Center (NCOC) said on Monday.
- **The country sees the lowest number of Covid cases since June 28** ISLAMABAD: The country reported the lowest number of Covid-19 cases in a single day since June 28.
- **PML-N MNA, senior leader Pervaiz Malik passes away.** Pervaiz Malik was an active PML-N leader in Lahore who had gotten elected five times as an MNA.
- **Islamabad's new hotspot as dengue continues to wreak havoc** ISLAMABAD: As many as 78 new cases of dengue fever were reported in Islamabad during the last 24 hours, health authorities said Monday, expressing fears that the nation might face an outbreak of the disease in the coming days.
- **Nine killed in the attack by gunmen in S Punjab.** LAHORE: At least nine people were killed by gunmen in Southern Punjab late on Sunday, police said.
- **India, China Military Talks Collapse: "Chinese Side Wasn't Agreeable"** Tensions have been high between India and China following a deadly border battle in June last year in the strategically important Galway river valley in Ladakh.

2. The “father” of Pakistan’s nuclear program dies at 85

What’s going on? On Sunday, Dr. Abdul Qadeer Khan died at a hospital in Islamabad at the age of 85. According to initial reports, Dr. Khan died due to complications from COVID-19. Western intelligence services reportedly considered Dr. Khan, “the father of Pakistan’s nuclear program.” He is the person who made Pakistan a nuclear power, wrote [The New York Times](#).

The details: [Prime Minister Imran Khan](#) tweeted that he is “deeply saddened by Dr. Khan’s death.” He also wrote that Dr. Khan’s critical contribution in making Pakistan a nuclear weapon state “provided us security against an aggressive, much larger nuclear neighbor,” (P.S. he was likely referring to India here).
