- **Alvi asks HEC to stop harassment, racial profiling of Baloch students** ISLAMABAD: President Dr. Arif Alvi on Friday directed the Higher Education Commission (HEC) and Quaid-i-Azam University vice chancellor Professor Dr. Muhammad Ali to take measures to avoid incidents of harassment and racial profiling of students from Balochistan at the institute's campus.
 - **LHC directs NA speaker to administer oath to Punjab CM-elect Hamza.** The Lahore High Court (LHC) on Friday directed National Assembly Speaker Raja Pervez Ashraf to administer the oath to Punjab Chief Minister-elect Hamza Shehbaz tomorrow (Saturday) at 11:30am.
 - **IHC asks FIA to stop harassing Sharif critic** ISLAMABAD: Islamabad High Court (IHC) on Thursday asked Federal Investigation Agency (FIA) and the police to stop harassing a prominent TV anchor after his lawyer petitioned the court, saying his client's fundamental rights were being violated by security officials.
 - **ECP dismisses PTI plea seeking Yousuf Raza Gilani's disqualification.** The Election Commission of Pakistan (ECP) on Friday dismissed PTI lawmakers' petition to disqualify Senator Yousuf Raza Gilani over "corrupt practices", saying he had no link to the case.
 - **Saudi authorities arrest five Pakistanis for hooliganism at Masjid-e-Nabawi.** Protesters on Thursday chanted slogans against members of PM Shehbaz Sharif's delegation at Masjid-e-Nabawi.
 - **Power crisis worsens as shortfall reaches 9,000 megawatts** LAHORE: Electricity supplies to homes, businesses and factories across Pakistan have been cut for several hours a day over the past few days as the country grapples with a 9,000 megawatts power deficit.
 - **Agricultural chemicals imports increase 75.01% in 9 months.** Agriculture chemical imports into the country during first three quarters of current financial year increased by 75.01% as compared to the import of the corresponding period of last year.

2. Election Commission responds to Imran Khan's allegations

What's going on? On Thursday, the Election Commission of Pakistan (ECP) [rejected](#) former Prime Minister (PM) Imran Khan's allegations about Chief Election Commissioner, Sikandar Sultan Raja, making decisions against the Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) party.

Reminder: Khan was ousted through a no-confidence vote in the National Assembly on April 9.

The details: On Tuesday, PTI's workers and supporters staged [protests](#) outside ECP offices across Pakistan, and accused Raja of having a "biased attitude."
