- **24-hour recap:** Pakistan reported **912 cases** and **26 deaths** in 24 hours. Pakistan also conducted **46,619 tests** in the span of 24 hours (P.S. this data was last updated on October 8 at 6:27 am).
- **Schools to open normally next week:** National Command and Operation Center (NCOC) head, Asad Umar, who is also the Minister for Planning and Development, announced that all educational institutions [would resume normal classes](#) from October 11 onwards. Before this announcement, educational institutions were operating with up to [50% capacity](#). Umar said the NCOC made this decision due to “the reduced level of disease spread,” and the launch of a school vaccination program.
