- **48 more die of coronavirus, 1,594 test positive across Pakistan.** Pakistan recorded as many as 1,594 new cases of the novel coronavirus in a single day with 48 more fatalities
- **PM Imran Khan promises special package for farmers.** Prime Minister (PM) Imran Khan has said that South Punjab was badly neglected by the previous governments
- **Five terrorists killed in North Waziristan IBO, announces ISPR.** Security forces on Sunday carried out an intelligence-based operation (IBO) in Mir Ali area of KP's North Waziristan, killing five high-profile terrorists
- **Turkish President launches welding of 3rd MILGEM corvette for Pakistan Navy.** Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdogan has underscored that the defence collaboration for the construction of warships is another milestone in Turkey-Pakistan defence ties.
- **Pakistan To Launch 5G Internet Network In 2022-23, Shows Report.** Pakistan is planning to roll out the most advanced 5G internet in 2022-23 which will accelerate the download speed 10 times to one gigabit per second (Gbps) and widen economic activities in the country, a media report said on Sunday.
- **Govt Okays Russian Vaccine For 'Emergency Use'.** The government has allowed another vaccine against Covid-19 under "emergency use authorisation" and given a go-ahead to a local pharmaceutical company for the import and distribution of the Russian-developed Sputnik V, an official confirmed on Saturday.
- **PIA Pays \$7 Million to Recover Aircraft From Malaysia.** Pakistan International Airlines (PIA) told the London High Court on Friday that it has paid around \$7 million (Rs. 1.124 billion) to Peregrine Aviation Charlie Limited for the two jets leased to it by AerCap.
- **UAE to open an embassy in Israel.** The UAE's Council of Ministers has agreed to open an embassy in Israel's capital Tel Aviv, the UAE government said in a Twitter post Sunday. The Council of Ministers' meeting was chaired by UAE Vice President Sheikh Mohammad bin Rashid.
- **Pakistan announce 17-member squad for first South Africa Test.** Pakistan have announced 17-member squad for the first Test of the two-match series against South Africa.
